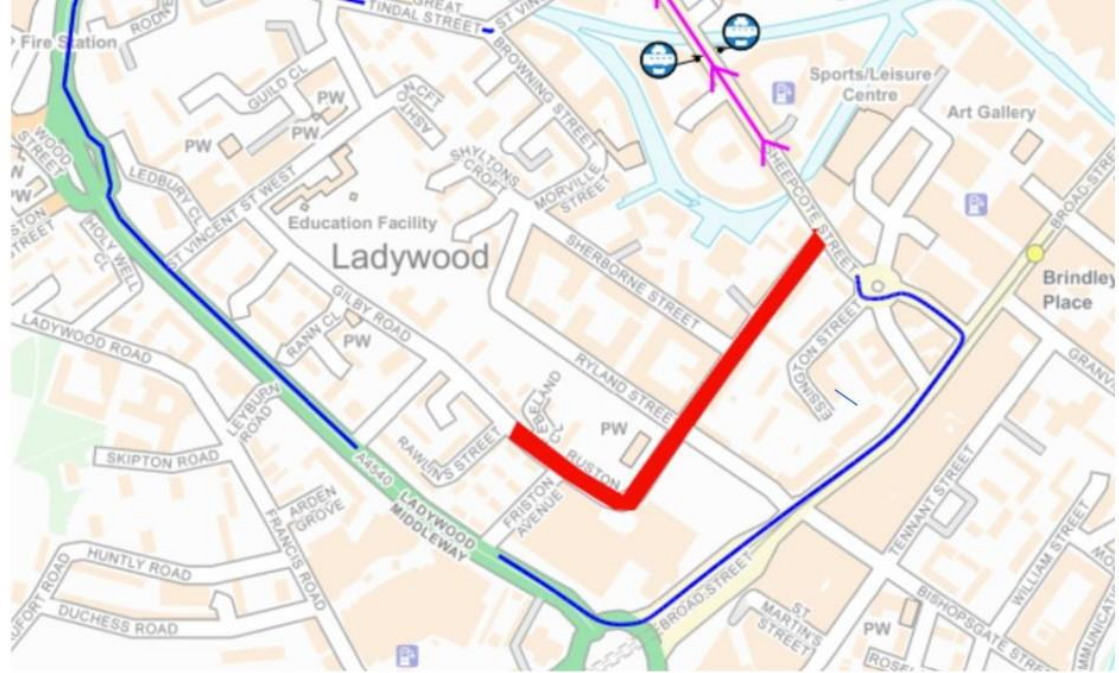


Brum newspaper's new Westside HQ

The Birmingham Mail, the city’s daily newspaper, is moving into new headquarters in Brindleyplace on Westside.

An advance party of a dozen or so staff are already working from the Three Brindleyplace offices, and once all the necessary technology is in place this will become the city centre base for around 80 workers, including Mail staff but also those producing the Sunday Mercury, the weekly business paper the Birmingham Post, plus hot-desks and meeting rooms for staff from Reach plc, the newspapers’ publisher.
