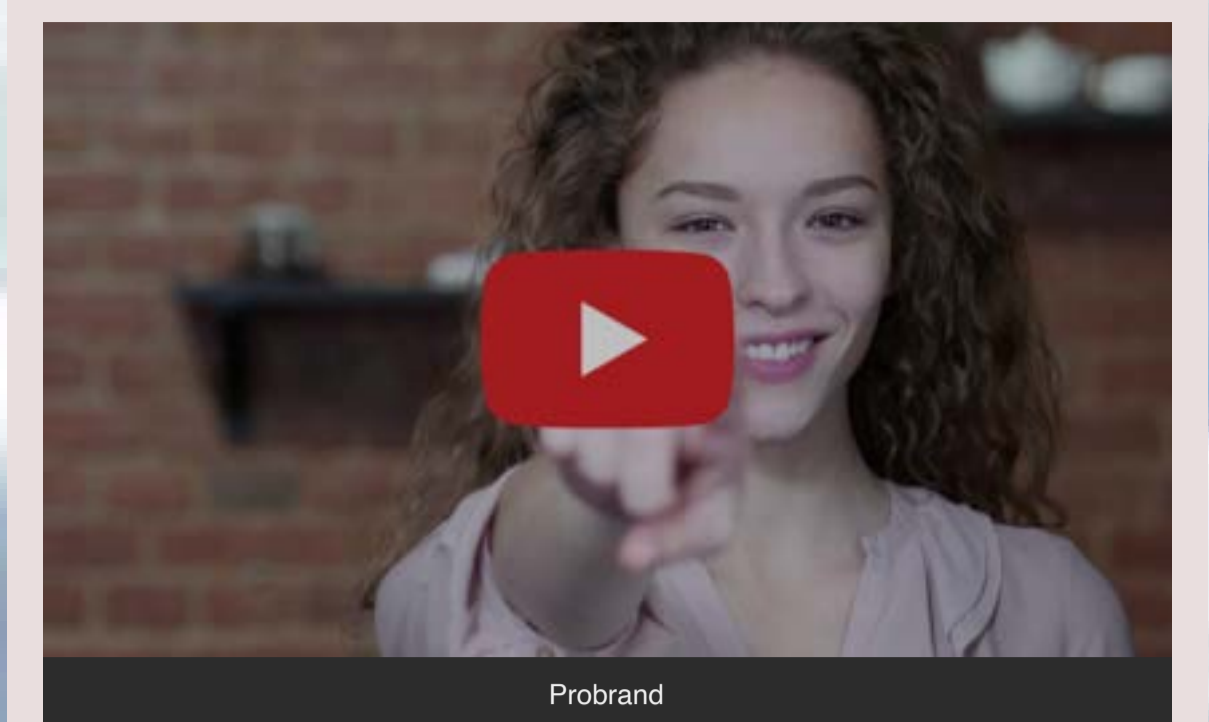

Q-Park goes electric for Westside visitors with new charging points

Bridleplace car park company Q-Park has turned its Brunswick Street address into an 'electric avenue' with the help of Blink Charging.

Its 890 multi-storey spaces now include 18 electric vehicle charge points – that's one per 50 spaces – as well as six disabled spaces accessible by cars below the maximum permitted height of 2.05 metres.

Charging your EV with Blink at Q-Park means you will be automatically entered to win 24 hours of free parking. And to speed up departures, drivers can dodge queues by entering and exiting with a contactless card.

As well as Brindleyplace, the car park is handy for the Crescent Theatre, Ikon Gallery, National Sea Life Centre, Utilita Arena and Legoland Discovery Centre.

Current Q-Park prices: £2.50 for one hour, £5 for two hours, £8 for three hours and £11 for up to four hours, £13 for five hours, £15 for eight hours, £17 for ten hours, £19 for 12 hours and £21 for 24 hours.
